What Does The Charter HOA Do For You?

- The HOA Board: seven members from your community who volunteer their time to help keep our community safe, encourage neighbors to engage with one another, and maintain the beauty of our neighborhood.
- **Advocacy:** meeting with the Lone Tree Police Department (LTPD), attending City Council Meetings, and informing residents about city and state legislation that could impact homes in The Charter.
- Property Values: ensuring residents follow the Architectural Covenant Committee (ACC) rules and
 regulations regarding property maintenance and appearance. Relocating work/utility vehicles, trailers,
 RV's and boats within the allowed time frame, and maintaining attractive yards and well-kept homes.
 Properties within an active HOA sell for 5-6% more than one without an HOA.
- **Standards:** homeowners comply with guidelines called Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions (CCR's) found in your Deed of Trust package at the time of closing.
- **Neighborhood Watch Program**: this dedicated partnership with the Lone Tree Police Department (LTPD) will be comprised of volunteers in our neighborhood community and enhances safety.
- Neighborhood Events: to create a sense of community, we organize Summer and/or Fall Festivals.
 These events often include a food truck, emergency vehicles, door prizes and raffles, kids' games and activities, and neighborhood information.
- **Holiday Celebration:** a Santa sleigh with Belgian horses and holiday singers that passes by every home in our neighborhood with holiday bells for the children.
- Yard of the Month: \$50 gift card typically awarded in June, July, and August. This award is given to the member home with the most beautiful yard that month. In December, \$50 is also awarded to the most elegantly decorated home.
- Annual Newsletter: goes out to each of the 312 homes in The Charter neighborhood to keep our neighbors informed on what is happening in our community.
- **Neighborhood Updates:** share time-sensitive information via email with The Charter neighbors about safety issues in our neighborhood like the presence of a bear or mountain lion, car theft/break-ins, home break-ins, etc. Contact us at mycharterhoa@gmail.com
- **Expenses:** we carry HOA liability insurance and pay a variety of fees to include State of Colorado registration fees and legal fees. These continue to increase year after year.
